The Blessing of Holy Week

April begins with Holy Week, April 2-9 with worship services on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. There are a few other special opportunities you can read about it on the following pages. I want to say Thank You in advance to our staff members and everyone who serves and shares their time and gifts as Vocalists, Instrumentalists, Media Booth Volunteers, Worship Welcomers, Deacons, Sunday School Teachers, Nursery workers, Children's Worship leaders, and those who assist with Fellowship Time. It takes a lot of people to do what we do at BBC on a weekly basis and especially with the extra services during Holy Week. It's a high point in the year as we remember and ponder what happened to and with Jesus every day of that history altering week.

In worship in 2023 we have been hearing from and learning about Jesus in John's Gospel and that will continue during Holy Week. In John, Jesus is presented as being thoroughly in control as events unfold day by day. I pray that you will participate in as much as your schedule permits so you can journey with Jesus from his entry into Jerusalem to the Upper Room, to his betrayal, arrest, and crucifixion, followed by the silence of Saturday, and the joy of Easter.

Following Easter, I will begin my third sabbatical in my 27 plus years at BBC. Jill and I plan to visit and assist Nathan and Zoe as they welcome their first child this month. I plan to meet with a ministry coach several

times. I'll work on simplifying and organizing things at our home. I intend to read about a range of topics including hybrid worship, preaching, and spiritual formation as well as for my own enjoyment. In May, I'll be attending virtually a four-day preaching conference called the Festival of Homiletics, and I'll spend a week in Puerto Rico toward the end of June for ABCUSA General Board meetings and the Biennial Mission Summit. My

father arrives on the 27th of June, and I look forward to time with him in Maine. I'll be participating in worship with my father and sons a couple of times which is a rare opportunity and gift for us.

While I'm away, ministry will continue, and there's a lot to

look forward to in the coming months including new members joining BBC. I know everyone will be gracious and understanding as we have several new staff members and Pastors David and Joe will be carrying more responsibility during my absence. As far as preaching, David and Joe will cover about half of the Sundays and we'll have guests who will be a blessing including my dad on July 23rd, the last Sunday before I return.

Jill and I appreciate the gift of time, rest, and renewal that a sabbatical represents, and we hope you'll pray for our family as we're absent from the special community that is BBC for a little while. We will miss you and look forward to returning energized and excited about the next chapter of ministry together.

Brewster Baptist Church has a new treasurer, David Wilcock. David took over the reins in March from our past treasurer Dan Ryan. Dan Ryan served for nine years and has done an awesome job! We will miss his leadership and are grateful for the many hours Dan gave to BBC in serving in this ministry.

A huge answer to prayer. BBC was challenged to give to the Africa House Renovation project to help missionaries Bill and Ann Clemmer. The goal was \$20,000. Pastor Doug

and staff were blown away by the generosity of our members. Over the course of month, BBC raised almost \$63,000 to help children (as young as age 5) to get off the streets and provide them with shelter, safety, and security. This money will also be used to purchase mattresses and blankets for these children along with providing safe shelter for them. It was great to see the church come together to achieve this goal and surpass it by so much!

Currently, we are 12 weeks into the new year. These numbers are current from January 1 – March 23, 2023. Typically, our stewardship numbers are lower in the 1st quarter compared to the other 3 quarters. The budget that was approved was for 2023 is \$1,320,000. This was a 7.5% increase in the budget from last year. For the first 12 weeks of the year, BBC's budgeted income was \$304,000. As of March 23, stewardship income was \$275,125.; which is \$29,000 below budget. Brewster Baptist Church's actual expenses are significantly lower as well at \$285,587 versus the budget of \$304,000 for the first 12 weeks. In summary, BBC has spent an additional \$10,463 above what has come in, a trend we expect to change in the coming weeks.

For the month of March, BBC received the American For Christ offering. Our target goal was \$7,500. As of March 23, \$5,590 have come in with another week to go to meet our goal. Additionally, \$2,395 has come in for the Deacon Fund.

The Finance Team would like to thank everyone for their generous support to Brewster Baptist Church. 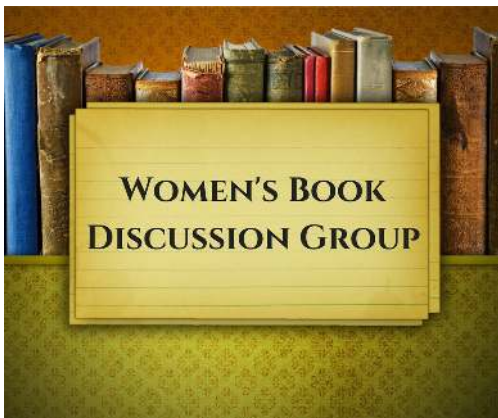

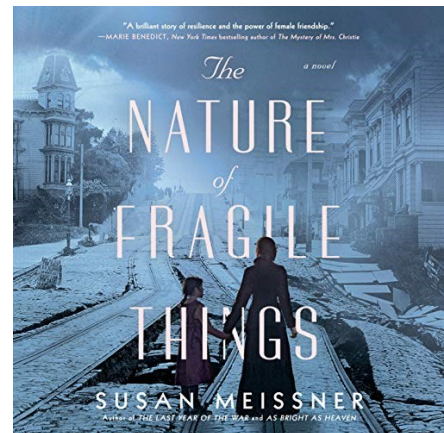

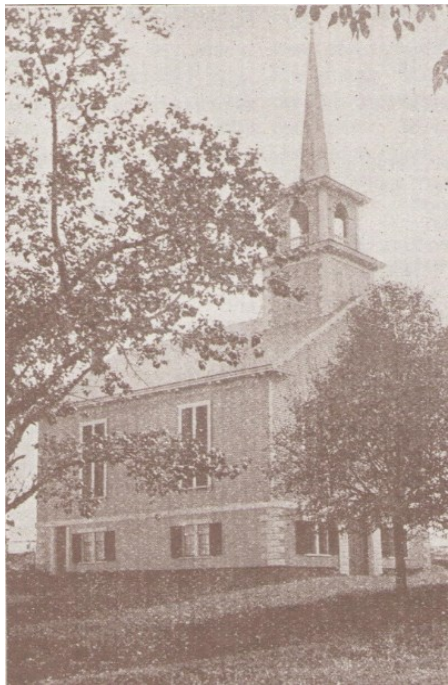
