Important Choices

The older I get, the more I believe in the importance of the choices you and I make every day. We're all shaped by our genetic inheritance. The saying, "You can't put in what God left out," is true to a certain degree. The environment into which we're born and raised also has a huge impact on a person. A child born to a poor unwed mother in Haiti will have a very different life than a child born to a well-off married couple in the United States. Genes and environment are significant life shaping forces for all of us, however, the choices we make are also crucially important in the life we have and the contentment and joy or discontentment and dissatisfaction we may experience.

At the end of September, I'll take a look back at a story from Exodus and the two different ways the people of God approach the situation confronting them. For them, and often for us with whatever we're coping with, we face a choice: "Am I going to complain and whine" or "Am I going to trust and obey". The former may seem a little easier sometimes, but the latter is much healthier and far better in the long run.

September is a time when the church-year ramps up with Sunday School and some of our small groups resuming, preparations for the Holiday Fair and World Mission

In worship in

September, we're going to be hearing from the Bible about some of the choices and decisions that each of us faces and the impact those choices have upon us. In *Matthew 16:23*, Jesus strongly warns

Peter, you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things." The choice we make hundreds of times a day about where we set our mind is crucially important to living a faithful life as a disciple of Jesus. In Matthew 18:15-20, Jesus talks about having the vulnerability and courage to have difficult conversations when someone has sinned against us or hurt us. That is a choice we face. We may not always handle those situations as well as we might or as Jesus instructs, but there is a sense in which in a family, in a work environment or a church, we need to recognize we're connected, we need each other, and handling conflict well is vital in order for a family, a friendship, or a church to flourish.



Offering get under way, and some of our people who work so hard throughout the summer are able to return to worship.

I want to strongly encourage you this fall to be investing in and inviting people to connect with God and

the community of BBC. People need the Lord, and they need the belonging, friendship, meaning, and purpose that being part of a healthy church can provide. All of us can choose to have people we're praying for, spending time with, and inviting to BBC on a regular basis. I pray you will try to do that.

I'm excited to see what God will do in and through us in the coming months and I pray that you will make your spiritual growth and engagement at BBC a priority so we can have a significant impact for God's kingdom and in the lives of as many people as possible.



We will kick-off our Student Ministry for the fall with the Amazing Race and pool party!



The Prayer of Jabez by Bruce Wilkinson Summarized by Martha Dunford

Have you ever wondered where you should throw your passion, training, and energy in your search for what God wants for you?

Consider the Prayer of Jabez in 1 Chronicles 4:9-10:

"Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil."

You see, Jabez was born in pain, and that is what his name means – PAIN. He needed to live beyond his limits. Let us look at this prayer's four parts and see what it means.

First, **bless me** – To ask God to bless you is asking God to prosper you, so that you can bless others. God pushes you forward and gives you more than you need to help others. This could be prospering you financially or with your spiritual gifts.

Second, *enlarge my territory* – Jabez was asking God to increase his area of influence. By increasing areas of influence, we will benefit others.

Third, **that Your hand would be with me** – If God is giving you more prosperity and influence, you are going to need God's hand or anointing on you. You are going to have to depend on God and not yourself. Now you begin to live your life with God's power.


Fourth, *keep me from evil* – This is praying for protection from the enemy, the devil. Spiritual warfare is needed to confront the enemy with spiritual authority to overcome all the power of evil. God will strengthen and rescue you.

We all have difficult times in our lives. Let us pray the Prayer of Jabez every day and see how God blesses us at BBC.



The Online Silent Auction will be held October 6 – 15 and the in-person Holiday Fair will be Saturday, November 4.

The Holiday Fair is BBC's primary fundraiser in support of our Cape Cod community. Since our first fair 18 years ago, **BBC has donated over half a million dollars** to help those in need.

Sharing God's Love in Practical Ways.

This year's Fair will benefit four local Cape Cod organizations.

- Cape Cod Foster Closet helps local pre-adoptive, foster, and kinship caregiver families by providing urgently needed clothing, shoes, books, toys, baby gear and furniture, formula, car seats, and more.
- * **Homeless Prevention Council** helps to stabilize individuals and families in crisis and provides access to food, clothing, furniture, transportation, fuel assistance, and housing.
- Sharing Kindness provides urgently needed counseling and programs in the areas of suicide prevention, mental health education, and grief support on the Cape and the Islands.
- Family Table Collaborative produces and delivers nutritious free meals to the families and individuals who need it most and provides educational programs highlighting healthy eating.
