Reimagining the Church

Throughout 2024, we've been celebrating BBC's Bicentennial under the theme, Remembering our Past, Rejoicing in our Present and Reimagining our Future. This month, as Sunday School resumes and church activities increase, our focus in worship will shift, beginning on September 22, as we start an eight-week series called Reimagining the Church. We're encouraging our small groups and Bible Studies to consider being part of this allchurch emphasis as we look at some of the images of the church that are found in the New Testament – and the implications

of those images for us as individual disciples and as a congregation.

The images or metaphors we will be examining in worship are: Disciples of the Cross, A Household of Justice, A Sign of the Kingdom of God, The Body of Christ, A

Community of Reconciliation, A Home for the Homeless, A Community of Resistance, The Family of God, The Temple of God, and God's Own Holy People. These images are found in the Gospels, letters from Paul and Peter, and the Book of Revelation.

As we look ahead to the fall and even beyond celebrating our 200th birthday on December 23, we want to make sure we're focused on being the kind of disciples and church that Jesus and God call and invite and command us to be. There's an old saying, "Methods are many. Principles are few. Methods always change. Principles never do." In the church, who we're called to be and what we're to do hasn't ever changed. We're to love God, love one another, introduce other people to Jesus and make disciples. The methods we use are continually being adapted - and it's remarkable how the reach of BBC has grown thanks to our services and Daily Devotions being available online.



Spiritual Formation

Upcoming Series on Reimagining the Church – Later this month, we're going to be starting an **eight week** series on reimagining the church by looking at the unchanging principles that God teaches and what that means for the church of today. Each week, we'll focus on a different image of the church from the Bible. This series begins on **Sunday**, **September 22**.

Small group materials will be provided for leaders, with helpful ideas and further thoughts on each topic to help you be prepared to facilitate the discussion.

BBC has a few Zoom accounts and would be happy to help a group set that up if there is interest for those who are not able to attend an in-person small group. Our men's and women's Bible studies, along with a couple of small groups, are already using a hybrid design, using Zoom along with their in-person groups.

FINANCIAL UPDATE

As we turn the page to September, BBC now enters the third quarter of the year. As mentioned before, the Financial Team put together an ambitious budget in 2024. The great news is that everyone has stepped up to the plate. Praise God!

The following numbers represent income and expenses through August 15, 2024. The stewardship budget through the first 32 weeks is \$918,159. Currently, we are exceeding our budget goal set at \$916,921. This is amazing, as we are entering the third quarter. It also puts us in a great position as we welcome Pastor Nate Ryan on staff. Pastor Nate's salary and benefits were not part of the original 2024 budget.

Our expenses to date are only \$836,715, which is well below our budget of \$916,921. All five major categories: Salary & Benefits, Operations, Ministry, Evangelism/Communication, and Missions are currently below budget. At present, BBC has \$81,444 in retained earnings. The Financial Team would like to thank all the leaders for monitoring their expenses so closely. The Financial Team does expect more expenses in the third and fourth quarters to bring things closer to the budget.

Missions has always an important financial priority, both in the annual budget and through special offerings received throughout the year. In July, BBC received the offering for OGHS (One Great Hour of Sharing). We received over \$13,000, which was beyond the goal of \$7,500. This year to date, our monthly Deacon Assistance Fund has received over \$43,250. This is a massive increase, compared to \$18,250 in 2023 at this time. Earlier this year, BBC received over \$8,000 for the America For Christ Offering!

In 2024, there have been several capital projects, both at our church and parsonage (getting things ready for Pastor Nate Ryan). Over the past month, at the 1832 Main Street parsonage, BBC installed a new boiler, hot water heater, kitchen flooring, and water line. Previous projects include: new security cameras, fire panels, two sets of accessible doors in the foyer, kitchen renovation in the church, sanctuary piano repairs, and sound system upgrades in Fellowship Hall. Thus far, BBC has spent over \$100,000 in capital expenses this year.

Overall, BBC is doing very well financially, and things look incredibly positive leading into the third quarter of 2024. We are grateful for your financial support! 

Hello, Dolly! is a 1969 American musical romantic comedy film based on the 1964 Broadway production of the same name, which was based on Thornton Wilder's play The Matchmaker.

Hello, Dolly! was nominated for seven Academy Awards, including Best Picture, and won three for Best Art Direction, Best Score of a Musical Picture, and Best Sound. This film represents the period 1884-1904, and is set in New York in 1890.

Released in 1969, *Hello, Dolly!* has the longest run time, 148 minutes, of all the movies we're showing this year because Director Gene Kelly couldn't bear to cut or shorten a musical number—so we will start promptly at 6:00 pm.

The film stars Barbra Streisand, whose singing is wonderful, Walter Matthau, Michael Crawford, Danny Lockin, Tommy Tune, Fritz Feld, Marianne McAndrew, E. J. Peaker, and Louis Armstrong.



Prayer Is Intimacy with God By Martha Dunford

The most important benefit from prayer that I learned over the past three years is this: Prayer is intimacy with God. When I come into His presence with adoration, love, praise, thanksgiving, repentance, requests, listening ears, and stillness, I fellowship intimately with God. When I am honest and tell Him everything, He draws near to me and fills me with His spirit. My intimacy with God deepens as I seek Him. Do I deserve it? No. It is not about what I do for Him. It is about what He did for me on the cross that allows me to be His child and to come boldly into the throne room of God. There I know His presence and His love. That is the greatest treasure of life, intimacy with God.

The Sermon on The Mount was Christ's manifesto on how to live God's Way. Matthew 7:7-8 says, "Ask and it shall be given unto you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened." Matthew 6:33 says, "Seek first His kingdom, and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." God provides His love and grace as I seek Him. He fashions tailormade experiences for me, and I cling to Him for He is my rock. After prayer times with God, I am refreshed, renewed, and peaceful. My hope is that BBC will develop a deeper intimacy and prayer time with God.

If you do not know Jesus Christ, you cannot know this intimacy, grace, and peace. The good news is God wants you to have it. Ask Him to forgive you for your sins and to come into your heart, because He died for you, too. He is longing for you to come to Him. Dr. Michael Youssef said it elegantly:

"It is the value of your soul that caused the God of power and might to hang helplessly on the cross ... Why? Because He loves you! ... He is stretching out His hands to you now and saying, 'Come to Me.' This is a great invitation. Will you accept it?"

Surrender your life to Him, and if you are searching for a church, Brewster Baptist will welcome you next Sunday. Our church family invites you to worship, to study the Bible, and to pray with us. Hope to see you soon.

Updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 and Flu Vaccines Available

The CDC recommends receiving both updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 and Flu vaccines to protect against severe COVID-19 and Flu this fall. Data continues to show the importance of vaccination to protect against severe outcomes of COVID-19 and Flu, including hospitalization and death. Last season, people who received a 2023-2024 COVID-19 vaccine saw greater protection against illness and hospitalization than those who did not receive a 2023-2024 vaccine. In 2023, more than 916,300 people were hospitalized due to COVID-19, and more than 75,500 people died from COVID-19. During the 2023-2024 Flu season, more than 44,900 people are estimated to have died from Flu complications. The CDC recommends that everyone aged 6 months and older receive an updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine, whether or not they have ever previously been vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine. The elderly and those who are immunocompromised are most at risk. Updated COVID-19 vaccines will be available from Moderna, Novavax and Pfizer later this fall. Stay tuned for more information.
