Guess Who's Coming to Dinner

While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and sinners came and ate with him and his disciples. When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"

On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." ~ Matthew 9:10-13 NIV

Throughout the Gospels, Jesus is

frequently depicted sharing meals with all kinds of people. Jesus seemingly never turned down a dinner invitation and sometimes, he even invited himself! Whether it was in the home of a tax collector or a Pharisee, Jesus knew the power of a shared

meal. This summer, from July 6 to August 17, we're diving into a new worship series called *Guess Who's Coming to Dinner*, where we'll explore some of the meals Jesus shared—and what those moments mean for us today.

In the Gospels, meals are never just about food. They're sacred moments of connection, teaching, and transformation. When Jesus sat down with people like Matthew or Zacchaeus—men considered traitors by their communities for collaborating with the Roman Empire—he

wasn't just sharing bread. He was offering them dignity, love, and a place at God's table. In doing so, he was also challenging the prejudices of the religious and cultural elite.

What's even more surprising is that Jesus didn't limit his fellowship to the outcasts. He also dined with devout Pharisees—those who often stood in direct opposition to him. Even in those sometimes-tense settings, Jesus remained open, challenging, and full of grace. He used the table not just to comfort but to provoke thought, break down walls, and redefine who belongs.



In this series, we'll ask ourselves important questions: Who do we invite to our tables? Whom do we avoid? How can our meals become moments of ministry—where mercy, acceptance, and the love of Christ are on full display?

Each week, we'll look at a different story from the Gospels where Jesus shares a meal, and we'll reflect on the spiritual, cultural, and relational impact of those moments. We'll see how Jesus turned simple dinners into transformational encounters—and how we're called to do the same.

This series is also an opportunity to take Jesus' example beyond Sunday morning. Consider inviting someone to dinner, or another meal, perhaps someone you don't

FINANCIAL UPDATE

Can you believe that BBC is halfway through 2025? Every year it seems like time is moving faster and faster. Summer is now upon us and our winter snowbirds have all arrived. Financially, BBC enters the summer months on high! Stewardship is up and above budget and expenses are below budget. Mission giving remains strength at BBC. All the numbers are through June 27, 2025.

BBC Stewardship Income is running 7% greater than last year. Currently, BBC has received \$793,000 and we only budgeted \$729,000. There have been quite a few people who have given their yearly pledge in the first half of the year which has helped the numbers. Overall to be above budget after six months is fantastic news. Thank you so much for giving to the mission of the church!

Overall, expenses are down in all five areas (payroll, operation, ministry, outreach, and missions) of our budget. BBC budged for \$793,000 has only spent \$703,000. The church is entering the second half of the year in an extraordinarily strong place. In previous years, we have spent the most money in the fourth quarter. Things are looking positive for the second half of the year.


Missions have always been a high priority at BBC, represented in both our annual budget and through our designated and special offerings. This year the Deacon Assistance Fund has received \$24,976! Which BBC has given over \$32,000 away to help those who are need. BBC has also received over \$30,000 for "Feed My Starving Children" initiative. Praise God!!! Thank you very much to everyone who contributed this year!

ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING

The One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) offering that we receive, beginning on Sunday, July 6, helps to provide relief to those suffering because of natural disasters or heartache caused by human behavior. Imagine what it would be like if you had to stand in line to receive a small amount of food to feed your whole household. The OGHS helps by delivering firstaid supplies, medication, and vitamins, all over the world – think about how life might be different for you, or for someone you love, to be without ready access to medical care and prescriptions. When mudslides and severe storms ruin crops, our gifts help to plant trees, start fish farms, and rebuild homes. Our goal for this offering is \$10,000.

- Understanding Grief and its Traumatic Aftermath


Other Summer Discipleship Opportunities


