Quite a Month!

October will be quite a month at BBC full of meaningful opportunities for worship, fellowship, service, and joy. Our group of three dozen pilgrims will return from our trip to Spain at the beginning of the month. I know everyone who went will have reflections and stories of how God has moved in their lives during this powerful experience of faith and travel, just as Pastor Joe did following his pilgrimage in Spain. These trips inevitably bless our congregation as those who return have grown closer to God and to one another and have their faith deepened.

Starting on **October 2**, Pastor David

Pranga and Jonathan Preu will lead us in a nine -week class using Dave Ramsey's course, "Financial Peace University."

Our students will be putting their gifts into action by preparing a delicious **İtalian dinner** on October 4, offering

not only a wonderful meal, but also a chance for fellowship and support for their ongoing ministries. This month, we will also gather as a church family to receive the **World Mission Offering**, a vital way we join hands with our Global Servants and International Partners around the world, furthering the Gospel and extending love to those in need.

On the first Sunday of the month, we'll celebrate World Communion Sunday, joining Christians everywhere in a sacred meal that reminds us of our unity in Christ across cultures, nations, and traditions.

Then, on **October 12**, we're excited to launch a new worship series entitled Six Things About God That Don't Change, based on the powerful words of the prophet Malachi. Small group materials will be provided, so that together we can continue the conversation and grow deeper in faith throughout the week, as we hear about — and discuss — some of the unchanging aspects of the character of God.

On **October 19**, we're thrilled to welcome back singer and songwriter **Jaime** Jamgochian, who will not only participate with us in worship during our Sunday morning services, but will also bless us with a special evening event of music and



BUILDINGS & GROUNDS

In the third quarter of 2025, Buildings & Grounds has overseen several projects:

- Exterior Rotten Wood Project: replaced 40 feet of facia for Community Hall, fascia outside of the kitchen, and trim on the Cupola; and repaired the leak in the Sextons' ceiling.
- Jerusalem Cross Front Entrance: power washed, filled cracks with polymeric sand and sealed with anti-slip sand.
- 6A Bluestone Walkway: excavated to remove roots, poured concrete base, and leveled.
- The Chapel was power washed.
- We continue to do our detailed quarterly inspection of the church.
- We've done many upkeep and maintenance jobs around the church, as well as the weekly mowing of the back field and parsonage, and trimming of all hedges and bushes.

FINANCIAL UPDATE

Brewster Baptist Church is entering the fourth quarter in an exceptional financial position. Stewardship is up over 9% compared to last year, and is currently above the budget forecast. Expenses are below what had been anticipated. This year, the Deacon Assistance Fund and Special Offerings are doing quite well, too. All the numbers are through September 24, 2025.

Currently, BBC has received \$1,200,671, and we only budgeted \$1,092,576. To be above budget after almost nine months is fantastic news. Thank you so much, everyone, for your generous support towards the mission of the church!

Overall, expenses are down in four of five areas of the budget (payroll, ministry, outreach, and missions). The only one above budget, currently, is our operations budget due to increased insurance costs and building expenses. BBC had budged for \$1,156,458, but we have only spent \$1,110,949. It is quite typical to be below in expenses at this point in the year. In previous years, we have spent the most money in the fourth quarter. Things are looking extremely positive for the last quarter of the year.

A special thank you to those who gave to our Deacon Assistance Fund — especially for in the last two months. Currently, BBC has received \$70,127. There has been large number of requests throughout the past few months. This money will help many families and individuals in need of assistance. It is great to have church a that cares so much for people going through a rough time in their lives.

Missions has always been a high priority at BBC, represented both our annual budget and through our designated and special offerings. BBC has received \$17,420 from our One Great Hour of Sharing offering, and \$14,015 from our America for Christ offering. BBC has also received over \$32,000 for "Feed My Starving Children" initiative. In October, BBC will be receiving the World Mission Offering to help with needs across the world. The goal is \$10,000. BBC is also receiving funds for the building of the new Habitat for Humanity Cape Cod home in Brewster. The cost of this home is \$55,000. Feel free to give to this adventure and please remember to write Habitat for Humanity home in the memo line. Thank you very much to everyone who contributed this year!

In 2025, there have been four capital projects. BBC had exterior renovations totaling \$10,308; the screen and audio upgrades in Fellowship Hall totaling \$3,705; a new front walkway for \$10,480; and playground repairs for \$18,411. The total of these four capital projects was \$42,905.



Each year, through International Ministries' (IM) World Mission Offering (WMO), thousands of churches and individuals come together to promote and support ministries that God is using to transform the world, as we invite people to become disciples of Jesus Christ, and to proclaim — through both word and deed — God's reign of justice, peace, and abundant life for all of creation.

Our goal for this year is \$10,000.

BBC's Wednesday Walks


