The Mountains of God

As you will see reading through this newsletter, March is an incredibly full month at BBC, including Deep Freeze for our students March 6-8, the Thrive Cape Cod Conference March 6-7, a movie night on March 13, a discipleship seminar on March 20, a women's retreat on March 21, an Easter family fun event on March 28, and four weeks of the Devotional Classics class.

Throughout March and into Easter Sunday on April 5, our worship journey will take us through a series titled "The Mountains of God". In the Bible, mountains are places of revelation, testing, surrender, and glory. They are the sacred spaces where heaven and earth seem to meet, where God draws near and transforms His people.

On March 1, The Mountain of Promise reflects on *Exodus 19:16-20* and *24:12-18*. At Mount Sinai, God called Moses up the mountain and established His covenant with His people. It was a holy moment filled with thunder, cloud, and fire — a reminder that God keeps His promises and invites us into relationship. On this Sunday, we'll also begin receiving the America for Christ Offering, participating together in supporting the ministry of our American Baptist Family in Massachusetts and across the USA.

On March 8, Pastor Joe Greemore will lead us to The Mountain of Power, based on *1 Kings 18:16-39*. On Mount Carmel, Elijah stood against the prophets of Baal and

witnessed the undeniable power of God. This mountain teaches us that when we stand faithfully for the Lord, His power is made known in ways that strengthen our faith and renew our courage.

March 15 brings us to The Mountain of Temptation in *Matthew 4:1-11*. Here, we encounter Jesus in the wilderness, tempted yet victorious. On this mountain, we're reminded that our Savior understands our struggles. Jesus meets us in our weakness and shows us that obedience to God's Word is our surest defense.

On March 22, I will guide us to The Mountain of Peace (*Matthew 5:21-26*). As we reflect together, we will consider how Christ leads us beyond anxiety and fear, into the steady assurance of God's presence. Even amid life's storms, the Lord invites us to higher ground, where His peace reigns.

During Holy Week, our journey deepens. Palm Sunday, March 29, takes us to The Mountain of Illumination in *Matthew 17:1-8*, where Jesus is transfigured before His disciples. On that holy height, Jesus' divine glory shines forth, revealing Him as God's beloved Son. This moment of dazzling light prepares us for the shadow of the cross, and reminds us that, even in suffering, God's glory is never absent.

On April 2, Maundy Thursday, we gather for The Mountain of Surrender (*Matthew 26:36-46*), entering the garden with Jesus as He prays, "Not my will, but Yours be

Join us as we climb the mountains of God and discover anew the heights of God's grace.

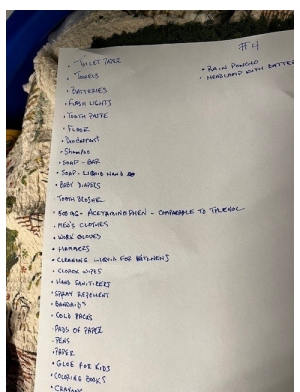
On Sunday, November 23, 2025, I had a conversation with Shawnnet Wray and Melanie Stone. Shawnnet was telling us about her life, her work on the Cape, and her impending trip home to her beloved Jamaica. She was saddened by the effects of the hurricane in October and wanted to get back to her family. She was telling us about some barrels that she had sent home. It was a Holy Spirit moment for me, because I just blurted out, "We could do that for you. The BBC community could fill some barrels for you." Shawnnet was so gracious. She said whatever we could do would be wonderful for her community.



I relied on the Holy Spirit to bring those who could help forward to help out. Shawnnet knew of the shipping company to connect with. I called them and they said they could deliver, pick up, and ship the barrels for us. They dropped off four barrels on Friday, December 5. It was advertised that BBC would accept donations between December 7-14. We received so many wonderful items for Jamaica from BBC parishioners in just one week – so much that we needed to add two barrels.

On Sunday, December 7, Shawnnet made it home to Jamaica. She wrote me, "I am home and giving God thanks. No electricity, internet, or water, but I give God thanks in spite of...[everything]."

God brought so many of you to help. We filled four barrels with most of what was donated, and requested two more barrels for the rest of the things. On Wednesday, December 17, six barrels were packed, prayed over, and put in a van headed for New Jersey the next day. On Monday, December 29, the barrels were loaded on a barge and headed for Jamaica. On Sunday, January 11, 2026, the barrels arrived in Jamaica.



On Friday, January 23, the barrels were being processed to be picked up soon. Shawnnet told me that many people in Jamaica had electricity now. On Monday, February 2, Shawnnet left her home at 4:00 a.m. to pick up the barrels in Kingston. They were opened and checked, then ready to be taken to her community. Everything inside the barrels was where it was when packed! Praise God that everything made it! Shawnnet made it home at 10:30 p.m. What a day. She sent a picture the next day or so of how she had organized everything to give out to her community.

This was her reply to seeing everything in the barrels, "I honestly can't tell you how I feel. Tears came to my eyes and my heart when I saw the many things you all sent to Jamaica. And the care and thought that was put into packaging

the items, it is just phenomenal. I can feel the love from Brewster Baptist Church towards Jamaica.” She has been distributing all the items over the past week and has been blessed by everyone’s reaction. She did say that some areas still don’t have electricity.

Thank you to ALL who helped out with this. The missions team, trans caribe (the shipping company), my husband (for his great packing skills), the pastors for their support and prayers over the barrels, and Shannet for her help in listing the items for the congregation to bring in, also for her love of her fellow people in Jamaica. Shannet shines God’s light so bright! A big thank you to ALL at BBC who brought items in and who prayed for this. Prayers were answered and people were loved and cared for. We were united in a purpose as a church to help others in need.

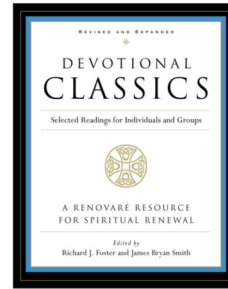
Healthy Relational Discipleship: Imitating the Way of Jesus

Devotional Classics Course

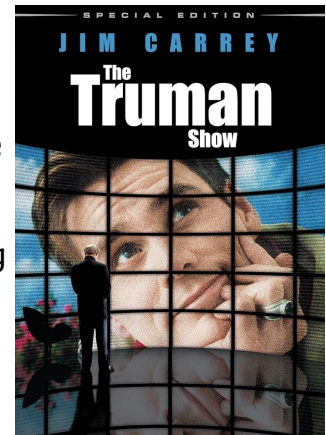
The Truman Show (June 5, 1998)

Theme for Reflection:

How do we know the world we're living in is actually true? Is a comfortable life always better than a true one? What might it cost to follow wherever the truth leads?

Introduction – A Theological Lens

The Truman Show follows the life of Truman Burbank, who, unbeknownst to him, has lived his entire life – from conception – as the subject of a Hollywood-produced reality television show set within a world carefully constructed around him. As cracks begin to form in that world, Truman is forced to wrestle with the truth about his life. In doing so, he must question the intentions and character of his maker, whether the comfort and safety of the world he has always known outweigh the risks of what lies beyond, and whether a life grounded in truth is worth the cost of leaving behind what is familiar – questions that invite us to consider whether we, too, are willing to trust that the God who created us calls us not into controlled security, but into truth, freedom, and a life beyond what we can see.

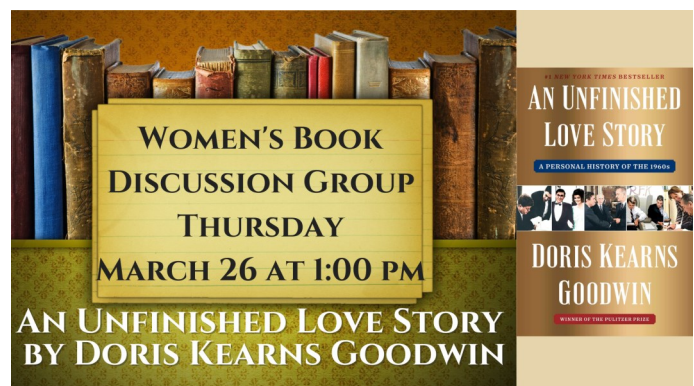
